## What Students are required to wear each day:

#### Day One

1. Full school uniform must be worn on first day for visit to Parliament House.

#### Day Two

- 1. Long pants, jumper and/or jacket, closed comfortable shoes, sun hat, beanie, hooded raincoat, sun cream, a small backpack.
- 2. Warm casual wear for night activities.

## **Day Three**

- 1. Comfortable warm casual wear, closed comfortable shoes (no thongs or open shoes), jumper and/or jacket, hat, sunscreen.
- 2. Warm casual wear for night activities.

It is important that students dress appropriately, as the temperatures at Canberra/Perisher range from a maximum of 15 degrees to minus 5 degrees at any given time.

Snow gear is provided, however, students need water resistant gloves, a beanie, and must bring a spare pair of shoes, as one pair may get wet.

#### **MEDICATION:**

- Students that require medication during the camp are requested to bring their medicine in a container, clearly marked with the student's name and instructions / dose. i.e. if you have asthma bring your Ventolin. Any medication is to be given to your supervising teacher prior to leaving for camp. Medication is to be in original packaging with labels.
- Please note that this also includes over the counter pain relievers such as Panadol and Nurofen. If you are concerned that your child may need such medication over the three days, please include this and provide to the supervising teacher.

Highly Recommended: Long johns/thermals and a book to read

All towels and linen are provided.

### Students may bring (should be stored in small backpack for when it is needed)

Pocket Money (\$30 maximum) Students will be responsible for looking after their own money. Camera (Teachers take no responsibility for money or valuables).
