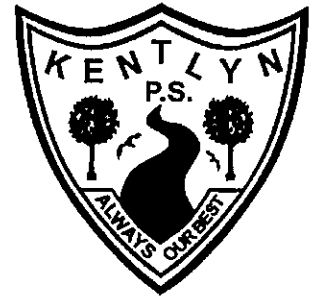

### **EDUCATION WEEK 2018**

Education Week (Monday 6 August - Friday 10 August) is a statewide annual event that celebrates public education in NSW.

*Today's schools - creating tomorrow's world* is the 2018 Education Week theme. It celebrates how NSW public schools are equipping young people with the skills and capabilities they need to thrive in a rapidly changing, globalised world. At Kentlyn PS, we will be hosting the following events:

#### **Monday 6th August**

Stage Spelling Bee finals (Stages 2 and 3) in hall at 9:10am.  
Athletics Carnival Field Events commencing at 11am on the council oval.

#### **Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> August**

Dress Up Day- The theme is 'In the Future'. Children may like to come dressed as a futuristic character or an occupation they would like to do when they grow up. Students are asked to bring a gold coin donation to contribute to Year 6 fundraising.
