Ruse and Public Schools Extravaganza – Monday 4 November 2019

On Monday November 4<sup>th</sup>, Ruse and Kentlyn Public Schools will be holding our first Extravaganza in the VMax Cinema at Event Cinemas Macarthur Square. Two years ago Ruse's first Extravaganza was a huge success and our students are very excited to be a part of it this year.

This event links directly to the Creative Arts Syllabus where students learn Dance and Drama skills. These skills will be performed through the Extravaganza. This is a whole school event where every student will be performing with their class as well as some of our in-school performance groups.

The story focus for Kentlyn Public School is as follows:

**K/1D & 1/2 E – The Gruffalo:**

Students have been split into the characters that were chosen by them. There are seven of each character and all will have a line to say in the item. The final script will be given to the students in the next few weeks for them to bring home and practise.

**2/3C & 4K – Tarzan**

Students have been allocated parts. If they are not a character they are a part of the chorus. Each class has their own section and then they join together at the end. The final script will be given to the students in the next few weeks for them to practise at every opportunity they have.

**5/6H & 5/6R – Alice in Wonderland**

Students have been allocated their parts. Every student is a part of it whether a character or chorus member. The girls who are not a part chose to be part of the tea party and the boys who don't have a part are the queen's guards. The final script will be given to the students in the next few weeks for them to practise at every opportunity they have.


The extravaganza is a whole day event. The students will come to school as normal and get dressed in their costumes. The whole school will then be transported to Event Cinemas by bus. Students will be supervised by teachers for the entire day/night with a parent/guardian required to pick them up from the cinemas after the show in the evening at approximately 8:30pm.

We are trying to keep costs to a minimum for the students by asking students to provide some items of their costume and paying \$15 which will include transport to the venue, costume and a between show snack of nuggets and chips.

As we are beginning to work out parts and teach students the songs and dances, we would ask for you to please let us know if there are any issues regarding your child performing in the extravaganza on the form below.
