Dear Parents/Carers

The Premier's Reading Challenge has begun! This challenge aims to encourage a love of reading and to enable students to experience quality literature. All students are encouraged to participate in this worthwhile literacy program, reading books at their level and interests.

K-2 students are able to have stories read to them as well as read by themselves. They will be supported in completing the challenge through shared reading activities in the classroom which teachers will add to their PRC reading records. Additional books may be added by parents if students are reading independently.

3-6 students must read their books independently and are encouraged to update their own reading records by accessing the PRC website via their student portal or the link above. Students can log-in using their DoE username and password, the same as they use when logging into computers at school.

Students must read a certain number of books to complete the challenge (see table below)

Challenge	Number of books you must read	Minimum number of PRC books	Maximum number of Personal Choice books	PRC booklists you can read from
K-2	30	25	5	K-2, 3-4, 5-6
3-4	20	15	5	3-4, 5-6, 7-9
5-6	20	15	5	5-6, 7-9

A student who completes the challenge for four years (non-consecutive) will receive a gold certificate; any student who completes the challenge for seven years (non-consecutive) will receive a platinum certificate.

The 2022 Premier's Reading Challenge will close on Friday 19 August.
